

Ferry Meadows to Norman Cross

This stage runs along the old A605 Oundle Road and runners may experience fast traffic. It is advisable to wear reflective clothing on this stage and to be accompanied by a cycle. If accompanied the cyclist **MUST** wear a reflective jacket complying with BS EN471 Class 2.

<p>Start by the bench and off along the path</p> <p>Beware runners coming towards you!</p>		
<p>Over the railway bridge and turn right.</p> <p>Follow the path all the way to the end.</p>		
<p>Go past the Marriott hotel and turn right.</p> <p>There is a footpath on the right hand side of the road between the junction and Alwalton, but once you cross the A1 you will be running on the road – take extra care!!</p>		
<p>Cross the A605 Oundle Road when safe to do so and run on the left hand side of the road, turning left into Bullock Road. (Make sure your cyclist stays behind you at all times).</p>		
<p>Pass both Elton Furze Golf club and farms on the left and after crossing over A605 turn left into Greenhill Road towards Haddon.</p>		

Turn left into Haddon Road just after the buildings with the orange slate roof. This will lead to you crossing over the A1.



Follow the curve of the road around to the right into New Road (ignoring the Green Wheel Blue sign directing you left) and head south alongside the A1.



Once round the corner past the Premier Inn Hotel you will see the Changeover point in the layby just to the left of the junction for the A15.

The memorial to the 1,770 prisoners who died at Norman Cross was erected in 1914. The bronze Imperial Eagle was stolen in 1990.

In April 2005, the Duke of Wellington, unveiled the restored replacement bronze eagle by sculptor John Doubleday.
